



## RCSNU 2250 (2015)

Resolution 2250<sup>1</sup> identifies five key pillars for action:

- Participation
- Protection
- Prevention
- Alliances
- Separation and reintegration

The resolution is considered historic because it urges Member States to give young people a greater voice in decision-making at the local, national, regional and international levels, and to consider establishing mechanisms to enable young people to participate meaningfully in peace processes.

The Security Council also requests the UN Secretary-General to conduct a study on the positive contribution of young people to peace processes and conflict resolution and urges Member States to "enhance, as appropriate, their political, financial, technical and logistical support".

<sup>1</sup> The title of Resolution 2250 is 'Maintenance of international peace and security', which is a reference to Chapter VII (Art. 39) of the United Nations Charter. Security Council resolutions under Chapter VII are binding.
