



The nine Guiding Principles on Engaging Young People in Peacebuilding:

- 1. Promote youth participation as a prerequisite for successful peacebuilding.**
- 2. Value and use the diversity and experiences of young people.**
- 3. Take gender dynamics into account.**
- 4. Enable youth ownership, leadership and accountability in peacebuilding.**
- 5. Do no harm.**
- 6. Involve young people in all stages of peacebuilding and post-conflict programming.**
- 7. Improve young people's knowledge, attitudes, skills and competencies for peacebuilding.**
- 8. Invest in intergenerational partnerships in youth communities.**
- 9. Introduce and support policies that address all the needs of young people.**
